Financial Benefits.

- a. These are often foremost in our minds, especially as many of us are retired or approaching retirement. I believe that membership of MCCEW will cut the running costs of your club. The administrative outlays in a club include ACCEO membership and Public Liability Insurance (PLI) for the Rallies. This can amount to about £110.00 - £300.00 per annum out of the membership fees to your Club.
- b. Affiliate your club to MCCEW and you will benefit from both membership of ACCEO and you will be covered for PLI on your Rallies

What does it cost?

Each member of your club must become a member of MCCEW with a payment of £5.00 per year per member and abide by the General country code issued by Natural England for the running of Rallies. Our five affiliated clubs have all benefitted financially from joining us. You could too!

We are also open to individual membership. (A member is a caravan /motorhome unit with partners and children).
